

Conditions of Play

1. The tournament organisers must receive entries by Monday 20/09/2010 with the relevant fees posted to us. **Please make all cheques and money orders out to "NSW Badminton Association". Or direct deposit or electronic transfer to National Australia Bank BSB 082135 A/c 02927 5745.**
2. Appropriate badminton attire must be worn when on court. Non-marking shoes must be worn at all times in the hall.
3. Events will be conducted in round robin format.
4. Each team must submit a separate entry form including the fees and number of players attending the dinner that evening.
5. Grades may be combined pending the number of entries.
6. Teams are to consist of 3 men and 2 ladies competing in grades A, B, C & D (subject to sufficient entries). The discounted team fee is \$100 or \$20 per player for State affiliated members with non-affiliated members paying \$25 each.
7. Any Club who have spare players and wanting to participate, please submit their names and contact details on the entry form. We will put them in teams that are incomplete and they pay that adopted team.
8. Match format has both ladies playing Ladies doubles and 1 Mixed Doubles. Each male will play either 1 Men's doubles and 1 Mixed doubles, or 2 Men's doubles. Each of the five players can only play a maximum of 2 events each.
9. Players at the Carnival play at their own risk.
10. Competitors must have reached the age of 40 yrs by the 09/10/2010

11. Hours of play: Saturday 09 October start 11:00 am to 5:45pm finish

Please be on time as we have to vacate the courts at the finish promptly

NOTE: (1) Entries will be a first come first in basis. Once there are 4 entries in a group (pool) this will be closed and other teams will be informed they will be on a waiting list to see if we can make up another pool of 4 in that grade.

(2) Also teams may be regraded depending on the ranking / strength of the players in the team submitted.

As this is the first time we are using this venue with 10 badminton courts, the priority for complete pools of 4 teams will be playing 2x21 points. In event of 6 teams, we will trial a full round robin using 1x30 points.
