

2010 UNSW Easter Open Conditions

1. The Tournament Committee shall have the entire management of this Tournament, and all decisions will be final. Please note grades offered over the weekend.
2. The Tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations laid down by the Badminton World Federation (B.W.F.) for the carrying out of Tournaments except as altered by these conditions.
3. Entries must be accompanied by the full payment of entry fees and must reach the Tournament Organiser on or before Tuesday 09/03/2010. All players registered with Sydney BA / Taree / Lismore / Coffs Harbour / Hunter BA / ACTBA / NSWBA are entitled to a member discount.
4. Players may wish to check the UNSW Badminton Club's website at www.badminton.unsw.edu.au on Friday 19 March 2010 for draws and playing schedule.
5. Each competitor must submit a separate entry form. The Committee reserves the right to re-grade any player from any event.
6. Players should proceed to the courts as soon as their names are called for a match. The match will commence 2 minutes after players arrive on the courts.
7. Events will be conducted in knockout or round robin depending on number of entries.
8. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to cancel any event if insufficient entries are received. Players who fail to turn up and/or proceed to the courts within a 5 minutes grace-period of their names being called face a forfeit of the games and will not be entitled to any refunds.
9. Although the Committee will make every effort to inform competitors of the match times before the tournament, it is the responsibility of each competitor to contact the organisers to find out their playing times before the day of the tournament.
10. Players are required to umpire matches when requested.
Subject to the number of entries, the Saturday Doubles and Mixed Finals will be played on Sunday at 11:00am

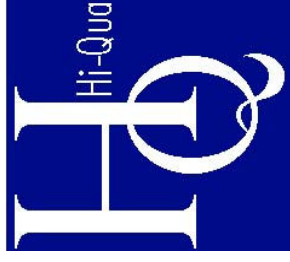

Variation to usual conditions:

Match scheduling

The organizers will be trialling strict match scheduling for this tournament.

As match times will be set prior to the day of the competition, all entries need to be confirmed (paid for) prior to the closing date.

Check the UNSW Badminton website (www.badminton.unsw.edu.au) for match times on Friday 19 March 2010.

Match scheduling will be strictly adhered to in the running of the competition and, as delays early in the day will result in a backlog at the end of each day, forfeits will be awarded where players do not present themselves ready on time. Players forfeited will not be entitled to refund.

Late entries will only be entertained in cases of withdrawals or extreme circumstances as determined by the organising committee.

Prize money

Prize money is available for all **A grade** events that have a minimum of 8 entries.

As prize money is offered, the organisers will strictly follow the grading list available from the NSW Badminton website. Note that the organisers reserve the right to reject or re-grade entries.

All graded events will be limited to a maximum of 18. If there are more than 18 entries, your place in the draw cannot be confirmed. Please Register Early.

This tournament will be used as part of the selection criteria for the NSW state U19 and Open teams competing in Launceston, Tasmania and Adelaide, South Australia respectively.
