The announcement of badminton being included in the Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games sports programme puts the sport in an exciting time to educate and unite communities, and improve quality of lives through sport. INspire aims to facilitate able-bodied and disabled badminton within the same social setting - "INcluding sports people in real environments".

This involves cultivating new badminton clubs to foster Para-Badminton development, and also help existing clubs to foster Para-Badminton activities. This will we hope progress to the development of a long term strategy aligned with Badminton Oceania's Para-Badminton development and performance programs.
