Badminton NSW invites your students to the 2024 NSW Inter-Schools Badminton Teams competition on Sunday19th May, 2024 to be held at the new Alpha Badminton Centre, Auburn. This new, larger number of courts Badminton specific centre will not result in limiting the number of teams that can participate in the event.

Save the date for the Winter Novice Inter-school teams' event on 25th August.

This School's Badminton Tournament provides students with an opportunity to experience the sport of Badminton in a competitive atmosphere and enjoy the day playing the sport with their friends against other school teams.

It is open to year 7 to 12 students who are not currently graded B grade and above, or past state badminton representatives. This is primarily a novice competition for those who are inexperienced or new to the sport. Team size will comprise 4-6 players. Schools may enter multiple teams which we request you rank your teams. Medals or trophies will be awarded to the winning and the runner-up teams. For separation of same school teams we will use Division 1 & 2.

The event is played in a round robin format within each pool of teams. The players are ranked by their relative strengths and play against other team players of equal ranking. Each round is composed of 2 singles and 3 doubles matches.
